

Updates to Bylaws Proposed:

After some discussion, Jerry Osborn moved that the officers should meet to review the current bylaws and present to the proposed updates to membership. Current 2019-2021 officers and incoming 2022-2024 officers will meet to review the bylaws in January 2022. Proposed changes will be emailed to members, then presented and voted on at the February 2022 meeting.

Updates proposed include, but are not limited to:

- Identifying the new Social Media Officer position and new text to define duties between the Secretary and this new position. (Page 8)
- Amending Article VI to include the Social Media position and updating bullet six to state that it is required that candidates for President and Treasurer must be members of at least one year, in good standing. (Page 7)
- Have a discussion about Article III in regards to associate memberships and member cards. Are they still necessary for the club or the bylaws? (Page 4)
- Same discussion about Article IV in regards to associate memberships. (Page 5)
- Do the defined terms for a Quorum still work for the club (Page 6)?
- Update the list of officers under Article VII to include the Social Media position and correct the title for Member At Large (listed as Sargent of Arms by mistake). (Page 9)
- Update the signature lines to include Social Media Officer and correct Member at Large. (Page 12)
